In talking with people at events, it seems that many people still don't realize that the **VSCCA now accepts applications for log books for cars through the 60's** on a case by case basis. Make your inquiries and applications to Jerry Greaves, or anyone on the Car Classification Committee identified in the front of the Roster, or on the website.

Many people also do not realize that **application may be made to all of our events by non VSCCA drivers and for cars without a log book.** That is why there are questions on the event entry forms as to whether you have a log book or not, and whether you are an approved VSCCA driver. If the answer is "no" to either or both of those questions, it doesn't mean that you should not submit the application. It's just a question, so that we know who you are, and what you are bringing, and in what class you would best be placed.

The reason why it is important that everyone understand this, is that The VSCCA is a club, not a business, and has no advertising budget. The only way information disseminates outside of the club, other than the favorable press that we receive about our events, is through word of mouth within the vintage racing community. **Please make every effort to mention this to everyone that you can,** either at other events that you may attend, or people who you know who think that they cannot run with the VSCCA. Any qualified driver, and any suitable car is welcome at most VSCCA events.

Case in point is our event at **LIME ROCK WITH THE JAGUAR CLUB in two weeks.** This event is even more open than many others, because even if a car with no VSCCA log book, or non VSCCA driver should not be acceptable in one of our classes for some reason, there are all of the Jaguar classes that could accommodate the car. And it is **unmuffled.** So there is virtually no car that can't run somewhere at that event. Please get the word out on this to everyone who you know. There is an announcement and entry form included in this mailing for the Jaguar event. If everyone would immediately think of one person they know with any sports car, send them the application, and tell them they can apply, it would be a wonderful and appreciated act.

Likewise, our **NEW EVENT AT MONTICELLO is open to all.** This track was built as a private retreat for Wall Street Execs, and is now available to us. There could not be a location that is more centrally located within our membership distribution. It is not too far south for those toward the north, and not too far north for those toward the south. If there is sufficient interest this year, and everyone seems to like it, we will be able to put it on the calendar next year as a two day event. Please support this event and give us your input, so that it is back next year.
