With that equal treatment from the snow Gods, came the necessity to re-schedule the **Southern Tech Meeting** to later March. We apologize for any inconvenience this may have caused, but it appeared to be necessary. Attached is a new announcement for that event, and we sincerely hope that you are able to make it.

Pocono will be a very significant event this year. It is a full two day event, and it is not on a holiday weekend. **Pocono hosts the primary school for the VSCCA**, so all of the clubs new members will be there. They do not need to have been approved for membership by the event; they only need to have submitted their application. Additionally, many of our clubs Event Chairmen, Officers and Board Members will be in attendance this year, as Event Chairs Andrew Perlman and Ryan Smith have agreed to host an annual meeting of this group in connection with this event this year. So it is really a great opportunity for you to have a great deal of track time, and meet and socialize with all of our new members as well as the leadership of the club.
