



**Announcing the Tenth Annual VSCCA "Governor's Cup"  
Virginia International Raceway May 16-17, 2009**

VSCCA members are enthusiastically invited to the tenth annual revival of the famous "President's Cup®" races, held at VIR in the late '50's and early '60's. This year's event will offer a substantial amount of track time and a low-key atmosphere biased towards the social side at what has become an annual fixture on the VIR and VSCCA schedule.

Track time at this event will be shared with the Mid Atlantic Alfa Romeo Club, much the same way as in years past. We will be using the 17-turn, 2.25-mile North Course. This course has terrific (130' drop at the Roller Coaster) elevation changes and several blind brows!

We always desire Pre-War, Under 1-liter and Preservation class cars in particular, but this is a great course for the very quickest cars in the Club, so come on down! You will get three sessions a day, two practices with one race Saturday as well as a practice and *two* races on Sunday afternoon. We have added a 40-minute Enduro mid-day Sunday for even more track time! No timing and scoring, no awards, just for *fun!*

The "Governor's Cup" will be a 2-day event, Saturday and Sunday, May 16<sup>th</sup> and May 17<sup>th</sup>. The entry fee will be only \$320, the best deal for track time in vintage racing! The Saturday night social will feature cocktails and an extra-cost catered sit-down dinner at the Clubhouse Saturday evening. For dinner tickets, please enclose an additional \$40/person, \$20 for children under 12. You **MUST** pay in advance.

Send in your entry postmarked on or before May 5<sup>th</sup>, 2009 and the entry fee is \$320. Late entries (after May 5) and "walk up" entries will be \$370. Please make all checks payable to "VSCCA, Inc." and send to Krause & Associates LLC, PO Box 727, Durham, NC 27702

We will have our usual format of VSCCA Club racing, with two practices and a race for each competitor on Saturday, practice, a forty-minute all-comers endure and two races Sunday afternoon with one early enough so people can get a head start back home.
