

"AN INVITATION TO ALL PREWAR ENTHUSIASTS TO ATTEND THE 39TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE HUNNEWELL HILL CLIMB -- FOR PREWAR and SELECTED POSTWAR CARS"

Wellesley, Massachusetts, Saturday May 16th and Sunday May 19th, 2009

For the thirty-ninth consecutive year, through the kindness of the Hunnewell and von Clemm families, the VSCCA will hold its hill climb on the paved driveway of the Hunnewell property on Pond Road in Wellesley (approximately 10 miles west of Boston, off Rt. 16 south of Wellesley Center - just beyond Wellesley College).

By request of the property owners, the cars eligible for this event are Pre-WW II cars, and selected Post-War cars. Postwar cars such as MG-TC and HRG are what we have in mind, but feel free to call the Event Chairman, Sandy Leith during weekday business hours, at (617) 725-2288 if you feel your VSCCA eligible car deserves consideration.

As has been the case now for over fifteen years, the only spectators permitted on the property are VSCCA members, their families and guests accompanying a member. Each entrance to the property will have a Wellesley police officer and a VSCCA roster and names will be checked. Non-members not in the company of a VSCCA member will be denied access.

Entrant's cars will be parked to the right of the house in the shade by the pool for the enjoyment of all present. The picnic area behind and at the side of the house is most pleasant with a beautiful view and plenty of room for our group and guests.

For those trailering a car, please take the first right off of Pond Road from Rt. 16 (formerly Sandy Green's), park your tow vehicle and trailer along the left side of the dirt driveway, unload your car and drive it to the Hunnewell estate (Hillhurst) less than a half mile down Pond Road on the left before 10:00 AM. If parking gets tight, the new owner of Sandy Greene's house is willing to let us park around the perimeter of his driveway, too. Trailers will not be allowed up the hill under any circumstance.

A changing room and shower stall will be available near the dinner location for those without local accommodations, thanks to Carol Bragg and the Wellesley office of RBC Wealth Management, Inc.

SPECIAL ANNOUNCEMENT: We have arranged a tour of a fabulous private WWII museum to take place prior to dinner. It may be back at Papparazzi, as last year, but we are in discussions with a possible side-trip prior to dinner which may change the location. Cost: \$45.00 per person. There will be a cash bar and private room so a firm headcount is needed no later than the application deadline of April 30th.

9:00 AM Sunday Rally - Gather at the foot of Hillhurst for planned 9:30 AM departure. Our rally masters, Ben and Carol Bragg will give us meandering directions to...a destination to be announced that morning! A noon-ish arrival at a facility where we can have lunch together will be the plan. The mileage will not be too taxing on your prewar or other

suitable sports car. While we encourage you to drive your vintage or antique car, modern cars will be accepted for the rally. Prizes will be awarded!

There is no cost for the rally if you participated in the hill climb, however a \$25.00 per car charge will be collected from those who want to do only the rally. Some final words on the Saturday Hill Climb!

We do require the following safety equipment: Fire extinguisher, Helmet (Snell 2000 SA or newer), Seat Belts (except rare cases in the exhibition class) and most importantly, good sense.

We will do a technical inspection of your car, so be sure it is ready for inspection and that your fire extinguisher is fully charged.
